9:00am - 12:00pm **Canine Good Citizenship (CGC) Testing**
Conducted By: San Mitchum *\$20 per test*
The Canine Good Citizenship (CGC) test is designed to test your dog's good manners and basic obedience training. It is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs with proof of current vaccinations. Each dog who passes the 10 step test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club (AKC).

Conducted By: Charleston Dog Training Club
Members of the Charleston Dog Training Club will show how Obedience Training can make your dog a more well behaved and sociable companion and member of the family. They will demonstrate the teamwork that is needed to compete in Obedience and Rally competitions and be available to share information about their club, training classes and answer general questions about training and competition.
